



Top Tips for a Simpler Life

Many people have their favourite shortcut or simple tool that helps them work quicker/better with their computer. Here are a few of mine that you might like to check out.

Snipping Tool – Built-in to Windows 7, 8 and 10. Great for taking a snapshot of all or part of the screen. Whether it's a bit from a website, or part of a document, the Snipping Tool helps you take a copy, which you can then save, or paste into something else.

Cute PDF – PDFs are by far the best way to send documents to other people. Whatever you are sending, if you convert it to a PDF first, then you can be sure that the person receiving it will be able to open it, and it will appear exactly as you intended. If you use a

recent version of Microsoft Office, you can already save documents as PDFs. But for everything else, download Cute PDF, then anything else can be converted.

PIN not Password – If you use Windows 10, then don't waste time with long passwords to get into your computer. Search for the Sign-in Options, and switch to a 4 digit PIN. Much quicker.

Google Image Search – If you have ever needed to find out where an image has come from, or need images of a similar type, use the Google Image Search. Upload the first image, and Google will search for other instances of that image, plus similar ones. Very useful for homework assignments.
